Rules / Regulations (for Parents):

General:

- The camp fees include accommodation for 2-days/1-night, 3-meals/snacks/drinks and outdoor activities.
- Please clearly label your child's belongings (including clothing, bags, etc). Toys, jewelry (for girls), and portable electronic devices (including DS, DSI, iPods, etc) are not permitted during Scouts Camp – Scout team won't be responsible for any lost or damaged items.

Safety:

- Please be sure to sign your child in (during drop-off) and out (during pick-up) – children must be signed out by an authorized person (parents or someone they formally authorize).
- No child will be permitted to attend the camp if he/she is feverish, vomiting, or has any other symptoms of illness.
- In the events of a medical emergency, parents will be immediately contacted. If both parents are unreachable, the emergency contact person will be contacted.

Behaviour:

Disciplinary Procedure:

For the safety and well being of all participants in the Scout camp, a disciplinary policy will be implemented to deter misbehaviour and disrespect. Disciplinary procedures are designed to help keeping a participant's behavior in accordance to Biblical instruction. Parent's cooperation is expected and appreciated in order for the actions to be effective.

The following behaviour will not be accepted:

- Dishonor to the church.
- Disrespect to others (ie. fighting or inappropriate language) and to property.
- Disobedience to counselors.

Acts of misbehaviour will be handled in the following manner (depending on the situation's severity):

- 1st offense: verbal warning and parents will be notified.
- 2nd offense: child will be dismissed from the camp immediately.

All consequences will be at the Priests' and camp leaders' discretion, based on each individual situation.

Any concerns with the camp, must be directly addressed to the Scout's leaders, not to the counselors!
